Can we join in the middle of the year?

Yes. Come to any Sunday meeting and start that day.

What about brothers and sisters?

We are a family pack. Boys and girls join the same pack, and siblings are part of pack life.

Is camping required?

No. Campouts are optional, and plenty of families start with day outings instead.

How much time does it take?

One hour on Sunday, plus whichever pack outings and events you choose to join.
